

Covid Secure Campus Checklist

At Bucksmore the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff is our number one priority. At each boarding school and university where we plan to run programmes in 2021, Government guidelines at the time will be implemented and adhered to. Enhanced measures will be in place to minimise the risk of infection and transmission of COVID-19. Based on current Government advice (October 2020), these measures **may** include some or all of those listed below.



- Contingency plan in case of infection in place
- All staff trained in how to deal with suspected cases of COVID-19
- Connected to local health centre/hospital
- Close consultation with NHS and PHE and Health & Safety



- Campus to be certified COVID compliant
- Coronavirus risk assessments in place
- Social distancing markers
- One way systems
- Hand sanitising stations around campus
- Serving staff to wear PPE and reduced capacity in dining hall



- Increased touch point cleaning (door handles etc.)
- Restricted access to personal spaces for cleaning staff
- Students provided with wipes and hand gel in accommodation



- Reduced capacity in accommodation to enable social distancing and limit numbers of students using shared bathrooms
- Restricted use of shared spaces in accommodation



- Groups of students segregated into “bubbles”



- Use of face coverings indoors or when social distancing is not possible



- Reduced capacity on transfer and excursion coaches to maintain social distancing



- Increased staff supervision during break times
